

SENSORY INTEGRATION ROAD RULES FOR INTERVENERS

- #1 Be aware of and beware of Sensory Integration
- #2 Plan all activities with the Occupational Therapist and/or Physical Therapist who serves the learner.
- #3 Know where the learner is developmentally.
- #4 Feed the skin: handle learner
- #5 **PLAY! PLAY! PLAY!**
MOVE! MOVE! MOVE!
- #6 Activities should combine senses.
- #7 Learning through functional activities is more important than learning through sensory stimulation.
- #8 Learner must participate with intentional movement. (As much as possible – If at all possible)
- #9 Learner should always **HAVE FUN**
