# **2023 Family Steve Perreault Award**



The award is given annually in recognition of Steve Perreault, who worked and volunteered in the field of deaf-blindness nationally and internationally from the 1970s until he passed away in October 2019. Steve promoted strengthening advocacy for families of children with deaf-blindness and helped found NFADB.

## Who is Eligible for the Award?

A family member of an individual with deaf-blindness who:

- ✓ Has shown outstanding service, advocacy, empowerment, or leadership
- ✓ Has had a lasting and profound impact on
  - one or more children or adults with deaf-blindness,
  - · families of individuals with deaf-blindness, or
  - deaf-blind community

# Who Can Nominate an Individual For the Award?

A family member of an individual who is deaf-blind who is a current NFADB member in good standing (<u>become a member at nfadb.org</u>\*)

### Deadline

Nominations must be submitted by January 15, 2023

#### **Nomination Process**

- ✓ Complete the <u>nomination form</u>\*
- ✓ Submit two letters of support:
  - One from a family member of an individual who is deaf-blind
  - One from a professional

#### Announcement of the Award

Nominees will be announced in late Spring 2023 and the Award will be presented at NFADB's annual meeting, July 11, 2023.
